2017 Camp Agreement

The Singer Island Outdoor Center (SIOC) hopes every student has a safe and enjoyable experience during the camp program. To ensure this, the SIOC has certain rules to prevent injury to your child while they are here. We are confident that each participant will have an educational and fulfilling experience; however, we take no responsibility for campers who do not follow these rules. Be aware that any camper, who disobeys these rules, whether or not injury occurs, may be asked not to return to the program.

If a camper becomes ill during a camp session, they should respect other campers by staying home and getting well before returning.

Please read the following release and promise. You and your camper must sign below to show you understand and agree to this release and promise in order to attend this program.

I acknowledge that the camp at SIOC is an outdoor program in which I participate at my own risk. I acknowledge that I may be outside in the hot sun for extended periods. I understand I can talk confidentially to one of my counselors if I have a problem of any kind.

Program Rules:

- To follow directions:
- Follow rules of the game
- Follow directions given by any staff member
- To respect yourself, staff, others and their belongings:
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Do not touch other people's belongings
- Talk quietly when inside the building
- Refrain from name calling
- To only do what you are allowed and instructed to do.
- Participate in activities:
- Become actively involved in the game or activity
- Be willing to assist with set-up & clean up
- Use appropriate language; refrain from inappropriate language and comments designed to hurt feelings or cause conflict.
- Stay with your designated group and do not leave the supervised area unless given permission to do so.
- Ask to use phones only in the event of an emergency.
- Be responsible for your own property.
- To respect the natural areas we will be visiting, and never litter.
- To avoid injury by following the rules and techniques that you will be taught.
- To follow SIOC policies and the rules of the State of Florida when it comes to dealing with wildlife.

I understand that if I do not follow these rules, there will be consequences for my actions.

Progressive Discipline System

The following consequences serve as a guide. Depending on the severity of the behavior, other actions may be taken.

1. Time-out/Cool down

- The participant will receive a warning prior to being placed in time-out.
- The time-out period will be utilized as appropriate.
- Time-out will be followed with discussion between the Senior Counselor and the participant. Discussion will include behavior, reason, consequences, etc.

2. Verbal Notification to Parents

3. Written Warning

- If the participant is placed in time-out three times in one day, the parents and the Education Manager/designee will have a discussion about the behavior, reasons, consequences, etc. This will be documented in writing and given to the parents. Depending on the severity of the behavior, parents may be notified in writing the first occurrence of the behavior.

4. Suspension

- Depending on the severity of the behavior, the participant will be suspended and upon return, a Behavior Contract will be developed

5. Behavior Contract

- An outline of expectations and consequences for failure to follow rules. Both the camper and the parents will sign the terms and conditions of the Behavior Contract.

6. Expulsion

- Participant gives away the right to participate in Singer Island Outdoor Center sponsored programs for the remainder of the Camp Program. No refunds will be given in the event of suspension or expulsion.

Zero Tolerance Policy:

The following actions will result in an immediate consequence which may include suspension or expulsion from camp:

- Possession of illegal drugs, alcohol and tobacco
- Possession of firearms or any generally recognized weapon
- Possession of fireworks or explosives or flammable material
- Behaviors or comments suggesting discrimination
- Fighting
- Making threats
- Stealing
- Inappropriate language
- Inappropriate behavior or comments of a sexual nature
- BULLYING

First Aid & Medications

Counselors trained and certified in First Aid/CPR will be with the camp group at all times, as well as fully supplied first aid kits. The scope and authority of our immediate camp staff is limited to basic lifesaving practices, first-aid and CPR, any incidents beyond that scope will be referred to emergency medical services. For all injuries/illness incurred at camp, that SIOC Camp Staff is made aware of, including minor injuries/illnesses, a camper's parent/guardian will be notified of that injury/illness. Depending on the severity of the incident, the camper's parent or guardian may be called, while minor scrapes and injuries may be communicated at the time of camper pick up. Any incidents requiring emergency services be called to respond, the parent/guardian will be contacted as rapidly as possible.

It is the policy of the Singer Island Outdoor Center that our camp staff **WILL NOT ADMINISTER** prescription medications to camp participants (campers). Over-the-counter medications, unless a specific need arises while performing first-aid, will also not be administered by SIOC staff. If a camper(s) requires medication, it is recommended that medication be administered by their parent or legal guardian prior to the beginning of camp and/or after the camp program has ended.

If Singer Island Outdoor Center cancels a day or week of camp due to dangerous weather conditions, or other conditions beyond its control, you will receive 100% credit towards another camp day or camp week. Any portion of less than one camp session is not refundable if weather causes early cancellation of camp. There is no refund or credit if you do not attend camp or your child is unable to attend. Missed days of camp cannot be rescheduled for any reason.
